BACKGROUND:

April 29, 1988	FLORIDA LOTTO™ is introduced with an estimated \$2 million jackpot.
May 7, 1988	The first FLORIDA LOTTO drawing is held at 11:00 p.m., Eastern Time, in Tallahassee, resulting in a rollover.
February 6, 1993	The FLORIDA LOTTO prize structure changes to provide higher prize payouts for LOTTO players.
August 1994	The Advance Play option, which allows players to purchase FLORIDA LOTTO tickets for future draws, increases from 26 to 52 draws for added convenience to Lottery players.
November 15, 1998	FLORIDA LOTTO jackpot payout changes from a 20-year annuity to a choice between a 30-year annuity and a one-time, lump-sum payment (cash option).
October 24, 1999	Wednesday drawings are added to FLORIDA LOTTO schedule, the matrix changes from 46 to 53 numbers, and players who matched three, four, or five of six numbers now receive substantially larger prizes.
March 2, 2008	The Florida Lottery adds LOTTO PLUS™. The \$2 LOTTO PLUS jackpot starts at \$13 million and the \$3 LOTTO PLUS jackpot starts at \$28 million!
October 11, 2009	FLORIDA LOTTO with XTRA® is introduced, replacing LOTTO PLUS. The \$1 add-on feature offers players the opportunity to win extra on non-jackpot prizes.
December 24, 2011	A \$50 million FLORIDA LOTTO jackpot is won, marking the 1,000 th jackpot-winning ticket in the game's history.
